- At more than 3 million in number, nurses make up the single largest segment of the health care work force.
- They also spend the greatest amount of time in delivering patient care as a profession. Nurses therefore have valuable insights and unique abilities to contribute as partners with other health care professionals in improving the quality and safety of care.

Current Scenario

Significant advances in biomedical science and in the complexity of health care, coupled with current and projected demand for nurses and nursing services worldwide, and numerous reports of unsafe and inadequate patient care, have prompted concerns about both nursing education and nursing practice.



Need of the Future

- All health professionals must be prepared with new knowledge and skill competencies to meet the social and scientific demands of clinical practice.
- Nurses can expect to take on new practice roles that involve family history assessments, screening, and case coordination for clients.

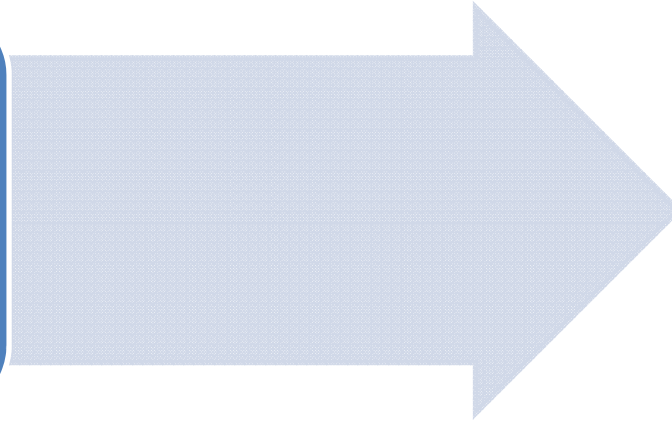


- Require nurses with more knowledge, more education, and more skills.

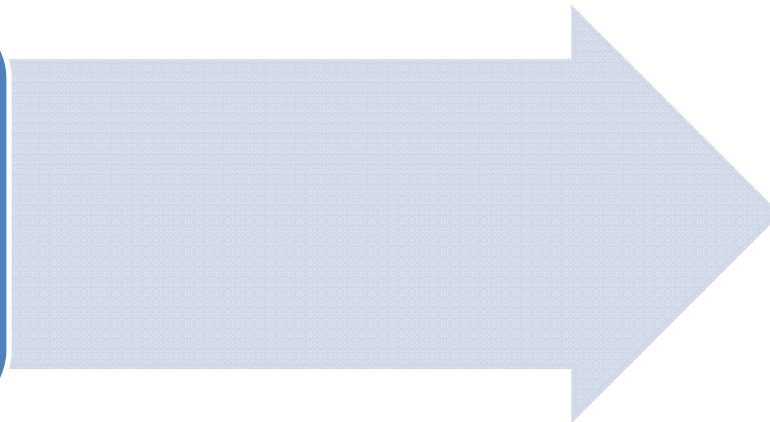

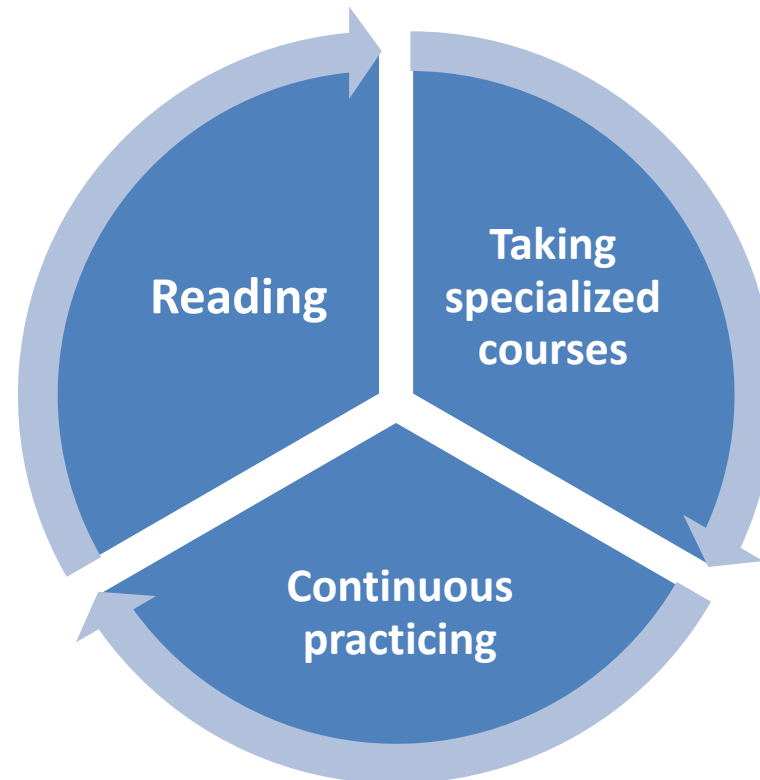
