

AREAS OF TRANSFORMING NURSING PROFESSION

- Nurses should practice to full extent of their education & training.
- Nurses should achieve higher levels of education and training through an improved and easily accessible education system
- They should be full partners with physicians in redesigning health care.
- Integration of practice, education and research in nursing care.







NEED OF TRANSFORMING NURSING PROFESSION (CONTD....)

- Enhancing the image of nursing profession to the public.
- Orderly transmission of organisation history, policies, protocols from experienced nurses to younger nurses



RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE FUTURE

- Remove scope of practice barriers.
- Implement nurse residency programs.
- Increase the proportion of nurses with a baccalaureate degree to 80% by 2020
- Double the number of nurses with some specialization by 2020.
- Ensure nurses engage in lifelong learning.
- Dissemination of information that improves nursing practice and hence patient outcomes.
